We'll also have Board games available.





Looking for Alaska by John Green
Themes: Friendship * Love * Happiness * Coming of age

I wasn’t sure what to expect when I decided to read “Looking for Alaska.” I was told that if I read any of John Green’s books it had to be this one. I thought maybe I’d be reading about some raw wilderness in Alaska. However, it brought me somewhere oddly familiar, a place I was slowly beginning to forget about. The more I read about Miles, the protagonist, the more I began to realize I’d been like Miles once. The more I read about the pranks he helped with, the trouble he got into, and the motivation behind it, the more nostalgic I became. This book is full of enough silly pranks and ridiculous rivalries that you’re sure to be entertained. However, this book also has a serious side to it. With themes such as friendship and love, you also walk away having learned something. I admire that John Green is able to accomplish this with such powerful storytelling and such interesting characters. You don’t have to be older than Miles to appreciate the novel.
