Would you like to hear officers explain their jobs? If so, then the Citizens' Academy is for you. The Upland Police Department will be conducting A 10 week Citizens' Academy tentatively scheduled to start in late October. The Academy will be held on Tuesday nights from 6:00 pm to approximately 8:00 pm. During this time, you will be presented with an overview of your Police Department, with all classes taught by members of the Department. Some of the scheduled topics/events are: administration, canine, traffic enforcement, the detective bureau, jail tour, ride-along, school resource officer, narcotics, homeless, community resource officers, evidence and the volunteer program. There is no requirement for any level of physical fitness in order to attend this Academy. However, there are some requirements that must be met. You must be willing to make a firm commitment to attend the entire course. Participants must be over the age of 18, live or work in the City of Upland, and have no prior misdemeanor or felony convictions.
